

## Star of the Sea Religious Education In-person and At-home options for grades K-12



Embracing the spirituality of St. Ignatius of Loyola, *Finding God* provides all the tools to engage the whole child—mind, heart, and soul—uniquely guiding children to engage with Scripture, practice prayer and reflection, and to find God in all things. *Finding God* covers full and authentic teachings of the Catholic Church and is rooted in Scripture, Church Tradition, and Ignatian spirituality. It starts children out on a life of intentional discipleship.

**Finding God will be offered in-person for grades 1-5 and at-home for K-8.  
Grades 6-8 in person will remain Edge. High School will remain Life Teen.**

**In-person: Grades 1-5** (*Finding God*) and **Grades 6-8** (Edge) will meet on Mondays 6:15 – 7:30pm in Crawford Hall. Please see calendar for class dates.

The following safety procedures will be in place:

- Face covering must be worn at all times.
- Temperature checks are required for all participants and will be via touchless thermometer.
- Covid screening – parents must follow screening agreement in registration form.
- Anyone showing symptoms will be moved to a designated “sick” area.
- Tables and chairs will be marked to maintain social distancing.
- Textbooks and supplies: There will be no sharing of supplies. Each student will be provided a bag with textbook and supplies.
- All areas will be sanitized each week.

**At-home: Grades K-8** (*Finding God*) lessons are expected to be completed weekly and includes online unit assessments. Please see calendar for completion dates.

Each registrant will receive: grade level textbook, easy to follow parent guides and a one-year subscription (password protected) to online materials. For parents with children in different grades, there is also a family quick guide to assist in teaching all children at the same time.

Online assessment center allows catechists to gauge the progress of each student. This includes unit online tests that will be monitored by the grade level catechist or Religious Ed Coordinator.

**Life Teen (grades 9-12) in-person or at-home options.** Life Teen meets Sundays 7 – 8:30 pm and begins with a kick-off night on Sept 20<sup>th</sup>. Please see calendar for all class dates.

In-person will follow the above safety procedures.

At-home participant will be able to participate live via zoom. The Religious Ed coordinator will monitor the chat for questions during discussion times and will lead small group discussion.
